Day 4 = Start Shading

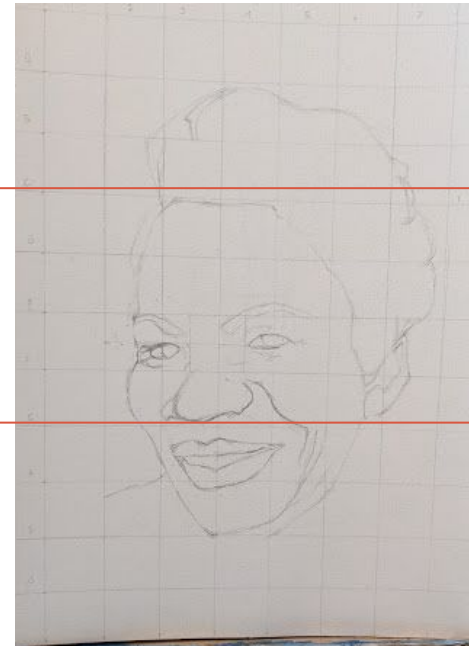

When is it due: **Friday 8-20 Which provides 2+ hrs**

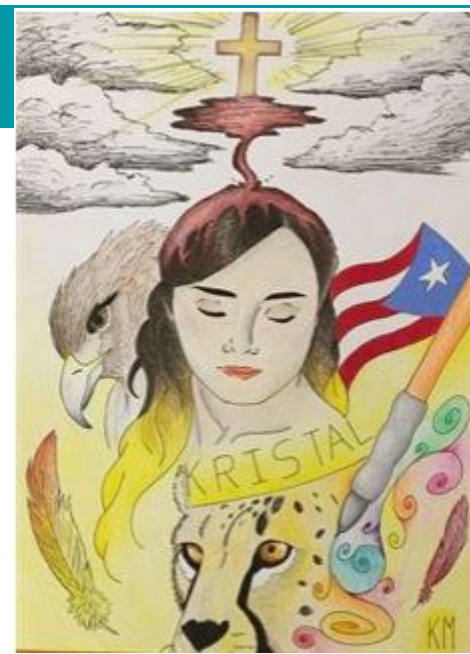
